Ongoing Traffic Management

The Experimental Traffic Order is now underway, please remember that the following restrictions will apply:

- A timed restriction to all vehicles between the hours of 11.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. Monday-Friday;
- A vehicle width restriction of 2.3 metres;
- A Restricted Parking Zone Mon-Fri 7 a.m. 7 p.m. and Saturday 7 a.m. 11.00 a.m. (the same restrictions that were in place prior to the works);
- Disabled access to be maintained throughout the day;
- Timed restrictions will not apply to users of car park at 111 Old Broad Street.

If you currently have regular or planned deliveries, please ensure your suppliers are aware of these changes and are using appropriately sized vehicles. It is strongly recommended that all deliveries are scheduled for when Austin Friars is accessible to traffic, and where possible, consolidate deliveries so they are less frequent. Any vehicles found to be contravening these restrictions will be liable to enforcement action.
