






Global Financial Centre

- £80bn trade surplus generated by the UK financial services sector in 2020, £75.5bn in tax in 2019, 10.5% of all UK tax
- 588 foreign companies listed in London, representing 20% of the global foreign equity listings
- 251 foreign banks in London, leading western centre for Islamic finance, with 22 banks supplying Islamic financial services, five of which are fully Sharia compliant
- \$110bn of worldwide premium insurance income in the UK in 2020. The UK has the largest insurance industry in Europe and the third largest in the world
- 18% share of global hedge fund assets in the UK;
 London dominant centre in Europe, managing around
 85% of European based hedge fund assets

Born On Broad Street: Gresham's Ground-breaking College
